Jury Finds Springfield Man Guilty of Burglary and Domestic Assault after Breaking into  
Former Girlfriend's Apartment

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson announces that Kevin Brandon Cash, 36, of Springfield, Missouri, was convicted on January 24, 2024, by a Greene County Jury of burglary and four misdemeanor assaults for breaking into his former girlfriend's Republic, Missouri apartment and assaulting her and others present. The victim had recently ended the relationship with the defendant. The defendant was found guilty of one count of burglary in first degree, one count of domestic assault in the fourth degree for assaulting his former girlfriend and three counts of assault in the fourth degree for assaulting others present in the home at the time of the burglary.

The jury trial was presided over by The Honorable James Carrier.
