MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO MURDER IN SHOOTING DEATH OF ANTHONY CORREA

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. – Greene County Prosecuting Attorney Dan Patterson announces that Lucky Leroy Keith Davis, 35, entered a guilty plea to Murder in the Second Degree, for the shooting death of Anthony Correa.

Davis entered a guilty plea before the Honorable Calvin Holden to one count of Murder in the Second Degree, contained in the original grand jury indictment.

On September 10, 2018, Davis ambushed Correa and two others in the drive way of 2550 W. Mill St., in a residential area of Springfield. Witnesses described Davis displaying a handgun and shooting multiple times, fatally wounding Correa, before fleeing the scene. Through police resources, law enforcement was able to identify the distinctive vehicle the Defendant fled in, eventually identifying the suspect as Lucky Davis.

Under the plea agreement, the defendant was sentenced to a term of twenty-five years in the Department of Corrections. Murder in the second degree is a dangerous felony which requires Davis to serve 85% of the sentence before he is parole eligible.

This case is being prosecuted by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Scott Lucy. It was investigated by the Springfield Police Department and Detective Cody Williams was the lead investigator assigned to the case.
